



WESTWOOD PLATEAU GOLFER EXPECTATIONS

ALL GOLFERS MUST ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING PRACTICES WHEN ON WESTWOOD PLATEAU PROPERTY

- **If you are experiencing any symptoms of sickness or have been in contact with someone who is not feeling well, please do not visit our facilities; we do not want you to spread the infection. Golfers exhibiting signs of sickness will be asked to leave.**
- **If you have just come back from another country in less than 15 days you are not welcome at our facility and must self-quarantine.**
- No cash transactions will be accepted on-site, tee-times paid in advance and final booking.
- Bookings of 2-somes and 4-somes only at the Country Club due to double rider golf carts. We recommend playing with those within your circle only.
- Golf carts are not available at the Executive Course.
- Park & Play in effect. Golfers are asked not to arrive more than 15 minutes prior to tee-off. Your sanitized power cart will be waiting for you by the front putting green with your tee-time on the power cart. Any food & drink ordered online will be waiting in the power cart. Please check in at the golf shop 10 minutes before your round and proceed to power cart 5 minutes prior to tee-off and drive straight to first tee.
- Rental club will not be available.
- Players must adhere to "Physical Distancing" at all times while at facility. (6'/two club lengths distance between yourself and others at the facility, including staff)
- Guests must wash/sanitize their hands upon entry and exit of facility. We suggest washing your hands for a minimum of 20 seconds as often as possible.
- On-course washrooms closed.
- Rakes and other high touch items removed from the course, smooth sand with your foot.
- If you can we encourage bringing disinfectant and using it throughout the golf course.
- Limit touch points throughout your visit wherever possible. No sharing of equipment.
- Flagsticks to remain in the hole, do not touch the flag. Cups are shallow enough to scoop ball out with your club.
- Do not shake hands at the beginning or end of the round.
- Keep all garbage on your person until end of round to help reduce touch points for our staff.
- Golfers are expected to empty power cart of all personal items, including garbage after their round in the provided golf cart drop off station.
- We suggest keeping all personal items such as cell phone and wallet in your golf bag to eliminate contact with power cart
- No loitering on facility grounds, including the parking lot.
